

Responsibilities and Achievements

In my role as an enterprise architect I have:

- Developed comprehensive strategies, presentations, reports and artefacts to influence ICT planning and investment. For example I have provided architectural input into ICT Strategic Plans which have become the key reference documents for ICT planning and investment decisions. I have presented to executive management on the business benefits of the PRINCE2 project management and Managing Successful Programmes methodologies. I have also undertaken considerable collaboration with business units, finance staff and ICT providers to complete ICT Profiling reports that covered their ICT Workplan, At-risk systems, Unsupported Technologies, Business As Usual operational costs, and ICT Resources Strategic Plan.
- Developed target state enterprise architectures that guide investment decisions. For example I collated and analysed current state data of the infrastructure layer (desktops, servers and network equipment) and formulated financial allocations for TAFE institutes and business units for ICT infrastructure replacement. My work guided the investment decisions of the Infrastructure Consistency project.
- Developed architectural roadmaps, standards and directions; conducted options analyses to support business case development and ICT procurement. For example as a member of the cross-agency On-shore Electronic Communication and Collaboration Services panel I assessed onshore/offshore, private/public cloud services including cloud email, desktop productivity suites, and collaboration tools for consistency, accuracy, clarity, compliance with invitation to offer requirements and identified any clarifications required. The established services panel ensures agencies get value for money and are provided with adequate and accurate information for decision making, and simplifies the purchasing process for both government and suppliers.
- Identified and assessed new and emerging technologies, products, methods and techniques to determine the possible use and benefits for the organisation. For example, I have used my knowledge of emerging technologies and products to investigate alternative solutions which could provide required software functionality. I have assessed new technology to determine its fit with the department's requirements, policies and standards and provide solution options for the client.
- Developed and managed stakeholder groups, including senior management and IM/ICT professionals. For example I have coordinated an Information Management Group which examined information governance and advised the senior management team on strategic and architectural issues.
