Opening of meeting

Items of Business

1. Minutes of the previous year

2. Financial statements and reports

3. Auditor appointment

Members passed a resolution as an ordinary resolution that JCA Accountants be appointed as WiT's auditor.

4. Director appointments

Members passed a resolution as an ordinary resolution that two Directors be appointed to the WiT Board:

- b) Nadine Fiers.

5. Transfer to a public company limited by guarantee

Members passed a resolution as a special resolution that:

- a) The application for authority to transfer the association's incorporation under Division 1, Part 11A of the Associations Incorporation Act 1981 (Qld) to a company limited by guarantee under the Corporations Act 2001 (Cth), part 5B.1 is approved.
- b) The following members of the management committee are authorised to make the application:
 - i) Kelly Wilkes, incoming Chair
 - ii) Nadine Fiers, Company Secretary
 - iii) Kelly Addison, Treasurer.
- The proposed name under which the association is to be registered under the Corporations Act 2001 (Cth) will be Women in Technology Limited.

6. Adoption of Company Constitution

Members passed a resolution as a special resolution that for the purposes of section 136(1)(b) of the Corporations Act 2001 (Cth) and for all other purposes, approval is given for the Company to repeal its existing Constitution as an incorporated association and adopt the new Constitution as a public company limited by guarantee.
